Position: Research Associate – Economics of Agricultural Research

Appointment: One year.

Qualifications: PhD in Agricultural, Food Industry Economics, or related fields. Demonstrated expertise in areas of applied economic analysis is required. Previous economic research and publications related to agricultural research on private firms in developing countries is required. Experience collecting and analyzing survey data from firms behavior and experience developing economic models based on this data is also necessary. Actual experience working with private agricultural input firms or Non Governmental Agencies in developing countries is desirable. The Associate will work with Rutgers faculty and researchers on project management, the development of data sets of private sector R&D and innovation, policies that influence private investment in R&D and innovation and the measurement of the impact of research and innovation.
